# Court Maintenance and Safety

# **Club courts and Clubhouse**

Lately some courts and even the Clubhouse have been left open/unlocked. Please help us out by doing a quick check before leaving the Club. Also any problems down at the Club with water, lights etc, please report to someone on the Committee so we can get it fixed straight away.

# Court Water Sprinkler system

Members will be aware that our en-tout-cas (sometimes referred to as clay) courts need to be watered especially during the hot weather. The majority of water is applied during the night and is controlled by a water time clock (on the main switchboard) with strict amounts applied dependent upon the time of year and recent weather. It is most important that neither the time and/or the sprinkler units around the courts are interfered with, otherwise the courts can be over or under watered with adverse results. In the event of any apparent malfunctioning, please report matter to a committee member urgently. Thank you for your co-operation.

# Leaf Debris on courts

At this time of the year the autumn leaves can make quite a mess on and around our courts. To deal with this situation we have a "leaf rake" type bagger on each of the front & rear courts. These will pick up/remove the leaves and small twigs/debris. Please finish sweeping right up to fences and, if possible, into corners of fences where we can organize the debris to be removed before it blows back onto the courts.
