### COVID 19 Update

#### **COVID RE-OPENING**

On 1<sup>st</sup> November Knox Council instructed all sporting clubs to redevelop their COVID Safe plans. Wantirna TC has re submitted our updated COVID Safe plan, and we are pleased to advise that in a letter from Knox City Council on 4<sup>th</sup> November access to Wantirna Reserve Tennis Pavilion is now available, subject to its operation within State Government restrictions. In compliance with Knox Council requirements a copy of the updated plan including answers to frequently asked questions will be available in the club rooms.

Here are the guidelines for Tennis Clubs/Venues as detailed by Tennis Victoria:

- If the premises is only open for community sport, you do not need to be fully vaccinated, or confirm vaccination status or comply with venue density limits.
  - o If you are opening the premises for other purposes (food and beverage, retail or social functions, gym), all patrons will need to be fully vaccinated and have their check-in status verified by a COVID Check-in Marshal and comply with density limits (1 per 4sqm for indoor and 1 per 2sqm for outdoor or up to 500). Toilets are excepted.
- The definition of *community sport* is all community sport playing activities that are authorised by the State Sporting Association. For tennis, this includes on court activities i.e. coaching, competitions, tournaments, training/social play and court hire.
- Clubhouses can open:
  - If the clubhouse is open for the purpose of community sport only, you do not need to be fully vaccinated, or confirm vaccination status or comply with venue density limits.
  - If the clubhouse is open for other purposes (food and beverage, retail or social functions) all patrons will need to be fully vaccinated and have their check-in verified by a COVID Check-in Marshal and comply with density limits of 1 per 4sqm. Toilets are excepted.
- Spectators are permitted subject to public gathering limits in the <u>Stay Safe Directions</u> No.28, in groups of no more than 30 (multiple groups must be spaced out).
- Shared equipment must be cleaned between users.
- All venues / clubs are required to have up to date and accessible COVIDSafe plans.

#### **EMPLOYERS / BUSINESS OPERATORS / COACHES**

- In addition to the above relating to premises, there is a requirement for employers to ensure all staff working at or in relation to a facility used for sport are either fully vaccinated or partially vaccinated (second dose due before 26 November 2021) as per the <u>COVID-19 Vaccination</u> <u>Workers Directions.</u> This requirement supplements employers' health and safety obligations and could apply to paid coaching staff and paid administrators.
- Shared equipment must be cleaned between users.
- All businesses are required to have up to date and accessible COVIDSafe plans.

#### PLAYERS / PARTICIPANTS / SPECTATORS

- Everyone attending a tennis club must continue to Check-in via the Service Victoria QR code app.
- Face masks are required in indoor spaces only for ages 12+ (unless a medical exemption applies)
- There are no travel restrictions between Metro Melbourne and Regional Victoria.
- Shared equipment must be cleaned between users.
- Players are encouraged to practice the COVIDSafe principles

As usual please always promptly report any safety or maintenance issues to a committee member or duty team captain/supervisor on duty and take steps to decommission any area (courts etc.) that may be a hazard.

### Courts Update

(Re commissioning post the recent lock down)

Unfortunately, we were not allowed access to the venue to restore courts before the resumption was granted and as a result some restricted access and court usage was necessary.

Consequently, we have been trying to fully restore the courts post the 4 months "lock out" but unfortunately, we also needed to expend time on other maintenance tasks & assisting with court 9 redevelopment.

#### We:

- Thank those members who have assisted via additional bagging & spreading of toppings from the bags provided around the courts.
- Ask that members please water the courts well during the upcoming hot weather and pay particular attention to bagging them from fence to fence.

#### **Court 9 works**

Members may have noticed that Council contractors have been very busy rebuilding Court 9. We anticipate this will be ready for limited use (by Juniors) before Christmas on competition days.

Unfortunately, we have had to decommission courts 8 & 10 but these will be brought back into service ASAP. We regret any inconvenience, but please understand it is part of the overall redevelopment of the venue.

When the contractors have concluded their rebuild activities, additional rolling will be required. Please volunteer when asked to help.

### CHILD SAFETY at WANTIRNA TO

It has been a while since laws were passed in the wake of shocking revelations regarding the widespread abuse of children by employees of various institutions right around the world, and the systemic attempts to cover it up and dismiss it. Sadly, we in Australia have not been immune, and therefore both State and Federal Governments have stepped up and legislated laws to address the failings exposed by various cooperative and not for profit organisations throughout Australia.

As a tennis club we have a Child Protection Policy which is mandated by Tennis Australia in conjunction with Tennis Victoria and must be adhered to as a condition of being affiliated as an Australian Tennis Organisation (ATO).

Wantirna Tennis Club is committed to promoting and protecting the interests and safety of Children.

#### WE HAVE ZERO TOLERANCE FOR CHILD ABUSE.

Everyone working or playing or associated with Wantirna Tennis Club is responsible for the care and protection of children and reporting information about any abuse. This also applies to parents and relatives of junior players here, and visitors. There is no judgement call allowed, any abuse must be reported and even if you become aware of incidents off our grounds the legislation is so wide that this must be reported also.

As a condition of our affiliation, we must have an MPIO or Member Protection Information Officer and our MPIO is Ross Roberts the Vice President of the club. His phone number is 0414 603 077 and his email is rrobcinerama@gmail.com. Ross will be the point of contact if you have concerns or queries. In addition, he will have an educational role informing and endeavouring to explain various aspects of child safety at the club.

In addition, all members senior, junior, parents and affiliates are on notice that more legislation with an even wider reach has already been passed and became law as at July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022.
